Based upon recent discussions between them, the parties have concluded that it is appropriate to resolve certain collateral matters without judicial determination. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and among the undersigned counsel for the parties, as follows:

1. Defendants withdraw with prejudice their motion dated March 20, 1992 for sanctions against plaintiffs and their attorneys for the filing in this action of both the complaint and the accompanying motion for injunctive relief, and will not seek sanctions against plaintiffs or their attorneys, pursuant to Rule 11 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, 28 U.S.C. § 1927 or any other statute or rule, for any conduct currently known to defendants, including without limitation the filing of any pleading or motion, undertaken before the date of this stipulation in connection with this action.

2. Plaintiffs will not seek sanctions against defendants or their attorneys, pursuant to Rule 11 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, 28 U.S.C. § 1927 or any other statute or court

rule, for the filing of defendants' sanctions motion dated March 20, 1992 or for any other conduct currently known to plaintiffs, including without limitation the filing of any pleading or motion, undertaken before the date of this stipulation in connection with this action.

3. All parties shall bear their own costs and expenses in relation to all aspects of the Rule 11 motion dated March 20, 1992, and this stipulation.
